

HEAD TRAINER POSITION

Centre Wellington Minor Hockey is taking applications for the volunteer position of **HEAD TRAINER**. The Head Trainer's position would be a direct link between the CWMH association and its trainers, and the OMHA. This position is a mandatory 2 year voluntary position within the CWMHA.

The responsibilities of the Head Trainer would include:

- *provide leadership in promoting and maintaining the HTCP;
- *promoting and ensuring that volunteer Trainers with the Association apply and abide by the Responsibilities and Code of Conduct of the HTCP;
- *monitor and provide feedback to volunteer trainers to ensure safety of all participants;
- *collect and monitor all forms related to injuries and ensure all injured players and personnel return to the game in a safe manner;
- *participate on a regular basis in hockey safety and risk management education activities.

All applicants must

- *hold current HTCP certification;
- *have a minimum of two years hockey experience in a trainers position;
- *have a strong interest in promoting safety in hockey;
- *be willing to act as a mentor/coach for all trainers in the association
- *and be able to provide timely responses to questions or requests.
