Non Resident Player (NRP) Guidelines

Rule – CWMHA will accept up to 3 NRP players as per OMHA guidelines. These players will be evaluated by independent evaluators and must be deemed to be in the top 13 players of an AA team. (17 for midget if the coach is filling the roster) A NRP goalie must be deemed in the top 2 goalies to play on the AA team. The goalies will also be evaluated by independent evaluators.

NRP Guidelines - 1) Out of town players must be pre-registered for hockey in their **Home Centre** and must arrive at the first try-out with their **NRP Passport** completed.

- 2) The home centre must verify that the player is eligible by age/resident to attend Centre Wellington for try-outs.
- 3) To be eligible the player is required to be the Minor Pee Wee age (11 years old) or older as of Dec. 31st of the current playing season.
- 4) Centre Wellington will accept a maximum of three NRP players per eligible team.
- 5) NRP players can register at the first tryout. NRP players must have their **PASSPORT** to pre-register. A **\$75**, **CASH ONLY**, **non-refundable try-out fee** will be collected.

At The Try-outs:

- 1) NRP players must arrive 1hr before the first try-out and check in with the Registrar. At this time a \$75 non-refundable try-out fee will be collected. NRP players will not be allowed on the ice without payment. No exceptions.
- 2) NRP players are guaranteed 2 try-outs, provided they register on time and payment is made in full.
- 3) NRP players will be assessed by independent evaluators separate from the coaching staff.
- 5) NRP players who are deemed to be in the top 13 players, for their eligible team, (17 for midget if the coach is filling the roster) will be provided with an "Offer of Commitment" to that designated team, within 14 days or before September 15th, for the 2015-16 season. At this time NRP players must register with CWMHA and submit

payment (half due immediately and half due by Oct. 15). Players will not be allowed on the ice until registration is complete.

- 6) NRP players must remember that rep teams require a 100% commitment and this will mean attending regular 6:00 am practices or travelling long distances in difficult weather.
- 7) NRP players who are offered a roster position in Centre Wellington must return to their home centre at the end of each season and repeat the NRP player process each year.
